ABC SEMINARIAN CHECKLIST

The following are items you need to consider carefully in preparation for seeking your place as a Professional Church Leader (PCL) in active ministry within the American Baptist Churches / ABC.

Candidate: Keep your membership in an American Baptist Church.

Candidate: Be sure that your Seminary Registrar's office has you enrolled in school

as an American Baptist.

Candidate: Take the American Baptist history / polity course in order to meet the

ordination requirements of the American Baptist Churches, USA.

Candidate: Know the ordination requirements of the region where this ordination will

take place.

Candidate: Enroll in American Baptist Personnel Services (ABPS) before your final

year in school.

This requires a Validation Form signed by the Executive Minister where you have your church membership or seminar sponsorship for one year.

Candidate: Update your ABPS profile the semester prior to graduation.

Candidate: <u>Meet your Executive Minister prior to your senior year.</u>

Candidate: Join the *American Baptist Ministers Council* in your region.

Candidate: Discover and utilize the resources of the Seminary for your first placement

in professional ministry.

Candidate: Attend conferences for seminarians to become better acquainted with the

ABC / USA.
